

Watering Instructions for Fall Planted Trees

Initial watering

- Immediately after planting
- Water thoroughly by filling the water bag with 20 gallons of water

After that

- One month later fill the bag again

FILL THE WATER BAG by inserting the hose at the top seam BETWEEN the two layers that make up the bag. The bag should fill and look like a 50-pound water balloon. It holds about 20 gallons. The water will seep out the bottom of the bag and moisten the soil over the next six hours.

MULCH should be 1" thick at the base of the trunk and increase to 3" to 4" thick at the outside of the reservoir. To prevent disease, never pile up the mulch around the trunk.
