

**CONSERVATION COMMISSION
FAIRFIELD, CONNECTICUT
MINUTES OF SPECIAL CONSERVATION MEETING
NOVEMBER 3, 2011**

The Conservation Commission of the Town of Fairfield held a Special meeting on November 3, 2011, in Meeting Room II, Second Floor Conference Room, John J. Sullivan Independence Hall, 725 Old Post Road, Fairfield, CT.

I. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. by Stanton Lesser.

II. APPOINTMENT OF ALTERNATES:

Elizabeth Jones and Douglas Jones were appointed to sit as full members.

III. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Hoyden's Hill Open Space – To Consider and Act on Alternative H. Smith Richardson Golf Course Pond Dredge Spoil Disposal Locations at Hoyden's Hill Open Space Area: Annette Jacobson advised the Commission that the Town of Fairfield currently has an inland wetland permit for pond dredging at the H. Smith Richardson Golf Course. The applicant is requesting permission from the Conservation Commission to dispose of the pond dredge material onto the open space area at the existing driving range – a plan prepared by Laura Pulie, of the Town Engineering Department was reviewed. Gerald Lombardo, Director of Parks and Recreation was in attendance to answer any questions of the Commission. Ms. Jacobson noted that Conservation Staff is recommending approval of the request. Milan Bull *moved* Frank Rice *seconded* to approve the request to dispose of the dredged spoil material onto the driving range area of the Hoyden's Hill Open Space area, as presented this evening. *Motion passed unanimously.*

IV. ADJOURNMENT:

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Elizabeth Jones *moved* and Kathleen Maxham *seconded* to adjourn at 7:36 p.m. *Motion passed unanimously.*
