APPROVED MINUTES

March 18, 2010 Work Meeting

The Fairfield Historic District Commission met on Thursday, March 18, 2010 at 4:30 p.m. in the Second Floor Conference Room of Old Town Hall, 611 Old Post Road, Fairfield, Connecticut.

ATTENDANCE

Present: Commissioners Ellen Gould, Bruce Graham, and Margaret Browning

Absent: Commissioners Henry Backe and Tim Smith and Alternates Adam Klyver and Tom Dailey.

Ellen Gould called the meeting to order at 4:40 p.m.

DISCUSSION OF PROPOSED HANDBOOK REVISIONS

The commissioners discussed the proposed new section on garages. It was felt that the section on outbuildings could include garages. After a lengthy discussion, Bruce Graham made a motion to remove the new proposed section on garages. Second by Margaret Browning. Motion carried unanimously.

Ellen Gould stated that Madeleine Mackenzie proof read the small brochure. The only error she discovered was following the role of the Historic District Commission. The current wording is providing reports and providing information. It was decided that this should read to provide reports and to provide information. Since these changes do not change the intention of the document, it is not necessary to have Notice this item.

Margaret Browning made grammar and spelling corrections to the proposed handbook revisions. All commissioners present agreed with these changes.

Ellen Gould stated that the section for Spruce Street needs to be incorporated into the Southport Historic District handbook revisions. The proposed section needs to be shorter and more concise. Margaret Browning agreed to work on this portion of the handbook.

Ellen Gould stated that there may be some interest in 472 Old Mill Road becoming a Historic Property. It is a 4 acre site located next to the Old Mill and was previously owned by the Perry family.

Bruce Graham made a motion to adjourn at 5:25. Second by Margaret Browning. Motion carried unanimously.
