If such determination be made, that the Commission shall direct the Director of Parks and Recreation to facilitate the planting of a tree to replace any such tree taken; which replacement tree shall be planted at the same park or grounds unless it is not practical to do so; and that the cost of tree replacement be pursued through whatever funding means as may be available. In the event that the policy of replacement cannot be accomplished due to inability to fund the acquisition and/or planting of the replacement tree, that such shall not be an impediment to the initial tree removal. If at any time the consideration of removal of one or more trees is on the Commission's agenda, that the Tree Warden of the Town of Fairfield be given actual notice of any such meeting.*
 - 3) *Per a request from the Chairman of the Penfield Building Committee, that the Parks & Recreation Commission approve the removal of vegetative brush and trees necessary to install the handicap ramp as currently designed and approved by the Penfield Building Committee.*
