Ron elaborated on his earlier email re: meeting with the museum director and mayor of Bridgeport at the Discovery Science Magnet School. Mayor Finch appeared interested in the idea and a Cablevision survey will determine their connection access. The school is planned to open in approximately 2 years. Ron stated that he was going to propose that the new school be allowed to apply for grant funding at some point, to allow the cable access to be completely installed.

GATA There is a new grant schedule that has been instituted. There will be no applications accepted before January 1. The return date will be by the end of March. Decisions will be made in April and May; in June the notifications will be sent. The first check will be issued in July and the second in September.
