Notice is hereby given that the Regular Monthly Meeting of the Town of Fairfield will be held on Monday, May 20, 2013, at 8:00 P.M. at the Education Center on Kings Highway East, for the following purposes:

2. To consider and act upon the Minutes of the Special Meeting held on April 22, 2013, the Regular Meeting held on April 22, 2013 and the Annual Budget Meeting held on May 6, 2013.
3. To hear, consider and act upon the following resolution as recommended by the Board of Selectmen:

“RESOLVED, that Michael Tetreau, First Selectman of the Town of Fairfield, is empowered to execute and deliver in the name and on behalf of the Town of Fairfield a contract with the Connecticut State Library for an Historic Documents Preservation Grant.”

4. To hear, consider and act upon the following resolution as recommended by the Board of Finance:

“RESOLVED, that funds be transferred from an increase in grant revenue in the amount of \$10,946.67 to cover the cost of the upgrade of the Marine Sewage Disposal Facility at South Benson Marina; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the First Selectman is authorized to make, execute, and approve on behalf of the Town of Fairfield, any and all contracts or amendments thereof with the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection.”
