**TOWN OF FAIRFIELD
SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 8, 2010**

The Solid Waste & Recycling Commission of the Town of Fairfield held its Public Hearing on Monday, February 8, 2010, in the Second Floor Conference Room, Independence Hall at 725 Old Post Road, Fairfield.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

1. CALL TO ORDER: The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Pistilli.

11. Minutes of the Solid Waste & Recycling Commission Public Hearing, January 7, 2009: Paul Krumins *moved* and Sheila Sullivan *seconded* to approve the proposed minutes.

111. Old Business

The Commission discussed strong possibilities of the FCR going to retro the IPC for single stream. They won't know the outcome until negotiations are completed.

The Commission also discussed the fact a recycling company might be willing to take the monthly residue from the IPC at no cost and recycle what can be recycled. This will be major savings to both the FCR and Connecticut state tax payers. The same company would be open to a "pilot" where they can drop off 10 or 20 yarders to collect recycled cardboard and 3-7 bottles. The Commission will be reviewing this further.
