

**TOWN OF FAIRFIELD
SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 13, 2010**

The Solid Waste & Recycling Commission of the Town of Fairfield held its Public Hearing on Monday, September 13, 2010, in the Second Floor Conference Room, Independence Hall at 725 Old Post Road, Fairfield.

CALL TO ORDER: The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:40 p.m. by Chairman Pistilli.

- **Single Stream Recycling**

Mr. Zemruski noted he will be meeting with SWEROC and CRRA regarding continuing the contract with IPC. – the proposed contract is eight years – they want a ten year contract. He also noted he will be presenting his recommendations to the SWEROC members.

Sharon Pistilli noted it would be positive to track tonnage systems – cost savings into businesses – have a meeting with Chambers of Commerce to make them aware of the situation.

New Business

- **Hazardous Waste Collection Results**

Mr. Zembruski noted he was pleased with the outcome of the Hazardous Waste Collection Results which took place on August 28, 2010 at Veterans Park.

Joseph Fisher noted it would be helpful if a sign could be placed at the entrance of the Hazardous Waste Fair specifying “No Latex Paint”.

Linda Crowley, 112 Lalley Boulevard, thanked the Town for doing such a wonderful job with recycling in her area.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Paul Krumins *moved* and Sharon Pistilli *seconded* to adjourn the hearing at 8:30p.m. *Motion passed unanimously.*
