**TOWN OF FAIRFIELD

CALL TO ORDER: The Public Meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Sharon Pistilli

Minutes of the Solid Waste & Recycling Commission Meeting March 12, 2012

Robert Stilson *moved* and Sheila Sullivan *seconded* to approve the amended March 12, 2012 minutes. The meeting of February 13, 2012 has no quorum therefore, no meeting took place. Motion passed 5-1. Paul Krumins abstained.

Minutes of the Solid Waste & Recycling Commission Meeting September 10, 2012

Sheila Sullivan *moved* and William Shoaf *seconded* to approve the September 10, 2012 minutes. Motion passed 5-1. Robert Stilson abstained.

Old Business

- **Storm Damage Updates**

Mr. Zembruski noted Hurricane Irene's storm totaled 70.4825 tons last year and this year's storm damage to date, is 1,734.21 tons.

- **2013-2014 Preliminary Budget Prediction**

Mr. Zembruski distributed and discussed the Budget Request and Solid Waste and Recycling 2013-12014. He will look into the expenditures as discussed and will follow up with the Commission,
