Sheila Sullivan updated the Commission on contacting the Town webmaster regarding the town website's migration to a new platform. She has had some discussion with Kathleen Griffin and Selectman Tetreau on this issue. She noted Town website needs to be updated. The website doesn't give direction and needs clearer instructions. Also, she had suggestions on changes to the town website, which she presented to Mr. Zembruski for review.

Mr. Shoaf updated the Commission on Greener Corners. He noted Chairman Pistilli is still awaiting an answer from TPZ as to how they find out who the point person is regarding what bins would be acceptable in the downtown and Black Rock and Post Road commercial areas.

Mr. Zembruski reported the \$800.00 for printing and binding did not go back into the budget.

The Commission questioned when the Scale House at the Transfer Station will be finalized? Also, will the fulltime coordinator will go back into his position.

Mr. Zembruski noted the scale house project is still under construction.
