REGULAR COMMISSION MEETING

The Solid Waste & Recycling Commission of the Town of Fairfield held its regular Commission Meeting on Monday, June 10, 2013 in the Second Floor Conference Room, Independence Hall at 725 Old Post Road, Fairfield.

- **Transfer Station Traffic Flow**

Mr. Zemruski noted they are working on redesigning the traffic pattern at the transfer station. Also, the haulers were given the options to go to Winter Brothers at Shelton.

Sheila Dravis spoke to Winter's Brothers at Earth Day and they were very informative and very enthusiastic about giving us a tour of their facility.

- **Single Stream Recycling**

Mr. Zembruski noted he is looking at opening up the transfer station, on the commercial side two days a week, where the small haulers can't go to Shelton.

James Garcia noted nobody is willing to haul to Shelton and it has to be five days a week.

He also questioned the rate increase regarding the tip fees.

Mr. Zembruski stated they will make it work for everyone.

Mr. Bowman asked the haulers to put a plan together so they can look into it.

Mr. Zembruski will meet with the haulers on Monday at 2:00 p.m. at his office to discuss the recycling at the transfer station.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Bill Schoaf *moved* and Paul Krumins *seconded* to adjourn the hearing at approximately 8:30 p.m. *Motion passed unanimously.*
