Re: Extension of State Project 50-218 Kings Highway Pedestrian Improvements

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

LOTICIP GRANT is an approximately \$ 800,000 reimbursable grant covering 100% of the eligible construction costs of the project. The grant will be utilized in extending the limits of the existing Kings Highway Pedestrian Improvements Project in an eastwardly direction from Fairchild Avenue towards Villa Avenue. The State DOT has requested this 100% reimbursable grant be combined with our TAP grant for administrative purposes.

Notes:

Because the grant requires expenditures before reimbursement, it must be formally approved by the BOS, BOF and RTM.

Assuming no setbacks, we should receive approvals from all 3 boards by the end of October 2014. The existing sidewalk improvement project is just starting the design phase, so the timing is right to extend project limits.
