Fairfield Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan Advisory Committee

Committee Charge

The **Fairfield Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan Advisory Committee**, in collaboration with the Greater Bridgeport Regional Council (GBRC), will create the *Town of Fairfield Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan*. The Advisory Committee will assist the GBRC in soliciting public input; identifying bicycle and pedestrian priorities; developing goals, objectives and recommendations for action; and ensuring that the Plan is clear, concise and functional. The Advisory Committee will recommend to the Representative Town Meeting and Town Plan & Zoning Commission for the Plan's adoption into the Fairfield Plan of Conservation and Development (POCD).

The **Fairfield Bicycle & Pedestrian Plan Advisory Committee** will be comprised of seven full members and two alternates. An alternate member may fill in for a full member at the request of the chair. A quorum is established by the presence of 4 voting members.

Staff representatives from the First Selectman's Office, Police, Plan & Zoning, Parks & Recreation, Board of Education, Conservation, Public Works/Engineering, Health Departments, Town Plan and Zoning Commission, RTM and Board of Finance, may serve as advisors to the GBRC and the Committee as non-voting members.

The committee charge will expire December 31, 2013 or once a plan has been adopted by the appropriate town bodies, whichever comes first.
