The BOF requested a follow-up on:

Dredging permit (application)

An application for a "Certificate of Permission" has been submitted to CT DEEP for the "South Benson Marina Entrance Channel Maintenance Dredging". The application number is 201904576.

This same application gets reviewed by the US Army Corp of Engineers for a CT General Permit.

The CT DEEP and USACOE review occur simultaneously, and we expect both of these permits to be in place by 7/1/19.

A Coast Area Management application must also be submitted to Fairfield Planning & Zoning for the deposition of material on Jennings Beach. We will have the CAM application prepared and ready to submit ahead of time, but we don't want to submit it at this time so we can address any conditions/changes that may result from the CT DEEP and/or USACOE permits.

The regulatory environmental window to perform this type of work is 0ct 1 to Jan 31 every year. We anticipate all permitting will be in place for us to bid the project in summer 2019 and begin the work on 10/1/19.
