Application Requirements

Applications must include the following:

1. Non-Refundable Payment: \$50 (Resident); \$250 (Non-resident) - *Cash or check payable to Town of Fairfield or completed credit card info*
2. Vessel Registration – *Vessel must be owned by applicant*
3. Vessel Liability Insurance – *Declaration page to show effective dates*
4. Vehicle Registration (1) – *Vehicle must be in the vessel owner's name and address*
5. Driver's License - *Copies are acceptable if by mail*

Important Notes

- Applicant must not transfer assigned permit to any other boat or owner. Doing so may result in permit forfeiture.
- Applicant must present proper identification on entrance to marina (car permit and boat decal on transom of boat).
- No craft using sails only as the sole means of propulsion may be launched from flotation docks or ramps at South Benson Marina
- Vehicle permit valid for parking in designated launch ramp parking areas ONLY
- Non-resident permits are limited to first 50 applicants

By signing this agreement the owner acknowledges that he/she has read and is familiar with the rules and regulations governing the Town of Fairfield boating facilities and agrees to be bound by said rules and regulations. The privilege of using the Town's boating facilities is in the nature of a license and is not to be construed as creating a bailment relationship. The owner of the vessel holds the Town harmless from any claim, suit, damages or liability caused by the owner, anyone working on the vessel, or the vessel itself. The Town assumes no responsibility for supervision or security.
